

PSYCHOTHERAPY FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE DEAF OR HARD OF HEARING

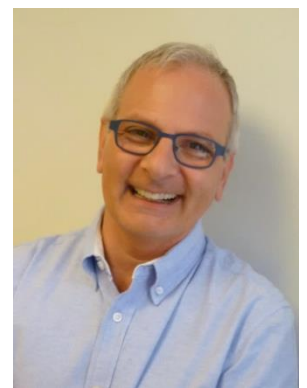
